# NON-RESIDENT TRANSFER TUITION STUDENTS

## School Board Policy E104

A child whose legal residence is outside the corporate boundaries of the Daleville Community Schools district may be enrolled in Daleville Community Schools under the conditions as outlined in this policy, effective June 1, 2014. As authorized by Indiana Law, the Board of School Trustees elects to charge no transfer tuition for such students.

1. The school board will set the enrollment capacity for each grade level no later than June 30<sup>th</sup> each year. The number of new non-resident transfer tuition students accepted will be based on the difference between the capacity number and the actual enrollment number for each grade level on the date of the random drawing.
2. The school board will establish each year, no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>, the date that any necessary random drawing at a public meeting will be held to determine which requesting students will be admitted as new non-resident transfer tuition students.
3. The school board will establish each year, no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>, the date by which all requests for transfer into Daleville Community Schools as new non-resident transfer tuition students must be received in the Superintendent's Office in order to participate in the random drawing. This date will be published on the school corporation's website and will be reported to the Indiana Department of Education.
4. Additional new non-resident transfer tuition students may be accepted after the random drawing into any grade level that is not at capacity. The Superintendent's Office will determine the schedule of when to accept those students.
5. All students admitted as non-resident transfer tuition students may continue to be enrolled as non-resident transfer tuition students each succeeding year.
6. Priority for admission of new non-resident transfer tuition students will be given to those transfer tuition students who have siblings who attended Daleville Community Schools in the previous school year, and to children of employees of the school district, who have submitted requests by the date established in section two (2) above.
7. At each grade level that has capacity to accept new non-resident transfer tuition students, a random drawing of applicants who have siblings who attended Daleville Community Schools in the previous school year, or are children of employees of the school district, who have submitted requests by the date established in section two (2) above, will be held to determine which requesting students will be admitted as new non-resident transfer tuition students. If the specific grade level still has capacity (as defined in section 1 above) after the random drawing above, then an additional random drawing of all other applicants at that grade level will be held to determine which requesting students will be admitted as new non-resident transfer tuition students.
8. Students will not be accepted as non-resident transfer tuition students, who have been suspended (as defined in IC 20-33-8-7) or expelled (as defined in IC 20-33-8-3) during the twelve (12) months preceding the student's request to transfer:
  - for ten (10) or more school days;
  - for a violation under IC-20-33-8-16;
  - for causing physical injury to a student, a school employee, or a visitor to the school; or
  - for a violation of a school corporation's drug or alcohol rules

Student discipline received under IC 20-33-8-25(b)(7) for a violation under IC-20-33-8-16, for causing physical injury to a student, a school employee, or a visitor to the school; or for a violation of a school corporation's drug or alcohol rules; shall be included in the calculation of the 10 days referred to above.

The parent of a student for whom a request to transfer is made is responsible for providing Daleville Community Schools with records or information necessary to determine whether the request to transfer may be denied under this section.
