MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC FORUM

HELD: MAY 11, 2012

A Public Forum of the Board of Trustees of Daleville Community Schools was held on Friday, May 11, 2012, in the Daleville Jr/Sr High School's Cafetorium. This meeting was held as an open forum for the public to ask questions and to share their vision of how they would like the School Board to lead the schools in the future.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm with the following Board Members present: Bobby Watters, Diane Evans, Vickie Rees, Kip Corn and Joseph Kaelin. Also present representing the schools were Superintendent Paul Garrison, Daleville Elementary School Assistant Principal Kim Beard and Daleville Jr/Sr High School Principal Rae Floyd. The School Board President, Diane Evans opened the meeting with a welcome to patrons and a pledge of allegiance to the flag.

The School Board President, Diane Evans opened the floor for comments and questions from the patrons.

The following are a few of the topics discussed at the meeting:

- Mr. Garrison had the following brochures for patrons:
 - Career Camp for Junior and Senior High School Students
 - Daleville Community Schools 2011 Report on Enrollment
 - The 8 Step Process Overview and Goals
- Tammy Staimpel expressed concerns about the present Basketball Program and head coach. She ask the School Board to consider making a change in the program.
- Diane Evans ask Mr. Garrison to give an update on Indiana Virtual School.
- Ms. Warren ask that Transfer Tuition procedures be explained.
- Ms. Warren ask how Property Tax monies were distributed.

- Mr. Garrison explained how Daleville Community Schools will be graded next year by the state.
- Ms. Barbara Timmons expressed concerns about our Jr/Sr High School Math Department.
- Diane Evans mentioned that Daleville Community Schools will sponsor a summer Lunch Program this year. Children 18 and under will eat free and anyone over the age of 18 can eat for only \$3.00.
- The School Board expressed how “Wonderful” both the Elementary School and Jr/Sr High School Art Shows were this year.
