A Public Forum of the Board of Trustees of Daleville Community Schools was held on Monday, October 1, 2012, in the Daleville Elementary School's Library. This meeting was held as an open forum for the public to ask questions and to share their vision of how they would like the School Board to lead the schools in the future.

- Jr/Sr High School Principal Rae Floyd talked on dual credit classes, after school tutoring and online classes.
